1. Reciprocity of the Agreement

All the prices, terms and conditions of the Agreement are reciprocal. This means that
Omantel and Ooredoo will be simultaneously considered as the Providing Party and
Requesting Party under this Agreement.

2. Bank Guarantee

 Netting-off principle shall be applied on the calculated bank guarantee amounts for both parties with the purpose of arriving at a single bank guarantee to be provided by the net payer.

3. Points of Interconnection (POI) Setup

- The current setup of POIs (fixed and mobile) between Omantel and Ooredoo shall remain in place. These locations are:
 - i. Ghala
 - ii. Seeb
- Any future changes in POI physical setup shall be mutually agreed between the Parties.

In view of the above, we seek your confirmation and counter signing of the Agreement and this letter in order to proceed with obtaining the TRA approval.
